What the Heck are "GEMS" and "eRA"?

GEMS:


- GEMS = Grants Enterprise Management Solutions.
- GEMS is the "modernization and consolidation" effort being undertaken by the Department of Commence to bring all the different Bureau grant programs under one "roof".

eRA:

- eRA = electronic Research Administration.
- eRA is our new grants management platform managed by NIH.
- **eRA Commons** is how YOU access the eRA platform.



Connected Systems for Grants Management



Overview of Biggest Challenges and Slowdowns

- Lack of access due to transition/shutdown October 2023
- Barriers to completing Post Award Actions
- Changes to account management (e.g., setting up PIs)
- Disruption in reporting structure
- Disconnections between eRA and BAS impeding progress
- Lack of clarity for NOAA workflow processes



Points of Progress

- (Mostly) fixed connections between eRA and BAS enabling new funding actions and financial reports
- Developing internal workflows for post award actions
 - Identified solution for No Cost Extensions (NCEs)
 - Identified solution to release Special Award Conditions (SACs)
 - Working on solution for reprogramming (extensions provided where needed)
- Developing processes for submitting and processing new awards and post award actions

Next Steps

- First Round of Progress and Financial Reports are due April 30, 2024.
- Moving towards a FY24 full award cycle in eRA
 - Developing NOFOs in eRA will look different
 - Translation from Grants.gov to eRA might be sticky
 - Please check out eRA tips and tricks document!
- Overall system change support remains limited focus in short term is on other DOC agency transitions to eRA
